**THE DAYTON TOWN COUNCIL MET MONDAY February 1
2010 AT 7PM IN THE DAYTON TOWN HALL. COUNCIL
MEMBERS PRESENT WERE MIKE HARRIS, RON MERKEL, JOHN
SWICK AND MIKE BOAS. JOE BUMBLEBURG, TOWN
ATTORNEY, WAS ALSO PRESENT.**

Mr. Harris called the meeting to order.

Mr. Boas made a motion to accept the minutes.

Mr. Merkel 2nd motion /motion carried.

Mr. Swick made comment that his last APC claim got lost and he would submit new one.

Mr. Swick made motion to accept registration of claims.

Mr. Merkel 2nd motion/motion carried.

Mr. Swick said that Miss Fahey needed a Letter from Town Council saying what Wards and "At Larges" the Town needed. Mr. Bumbleburg said that he would write the letter to Mrs. Fahey.

Mr. Swick said a letter needed to be sent to APC stating that he was appointed again to the Area Plan. Mr. Bumbleburg said that he would take care of this letter.

Mr. Dick gave his police report

Mr. Parker of Wee Engineering discussed the zoning of his property at 698 Walnut Street. When he bought the property, he was told that it was zoned GB. Now he finds that his property was re-zoned to NBU four months before he bought it; unknown to the sellers. Now he has to re-zone to GB to sell it or operate as he has been for the last 8 years. Will the Town Board support his request to GB? Mr. Bumbleburg said that Mr. Parker must first go through the GB process with AP, then come to Dayton Town Board to get their approval. The Town cannot discuss this matter until it proceeds through APC. Mr. Parker said that we would proceed with the rezoning with the Area Plan and would talk to the Town Board in the future.

Mr. Dawson of the Scouts asked the Board to look at the costs and artwork for Dayton flags and entrance signs.

Mr. Swick asked to set a time for discussion of the Town Salary Ordinances & Employee Policies.

Mr. Boas made a motion for an Executive Session of the Town Council for Monday February 8th, 2010 at 6 p.m. to discuss personnel policies and employee Evaluations.

Mr. Swick made a motion to adjourn.

Mr. Merkel seconded the motion. The motion carried and the Meeting was adjourned.
