

THE TOWN OF DAYTON INDIANA

THE DAYTON TOWN COUNCIL MET MONDAY APRIL 4, 2011 AT 7PM IN THE DAYTON TOWN HALL. COUNCIL MEMBERS PRESENT WERE MIKE BOAS, MIKE HARRIS, JOHN SWICK AND RON MERKEL. CHERYL KNODLE, TOWN ATTORNEY, WAS ALSO PRESENT.

Mr. Harris called the meeting to order.

Mr. Swick made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Mr. Boas seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Merkel made a motion to approve the Registry of Claims. Mr. Swick seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Harris made a motion to approve the bill of \$4600 for new sidewalk work at Brand's property along Dayton road. Mr. Merkel seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Dick gave his police report which was reduced to writing and attached to the minutes. Mr. Swick asked for a copy of the police report from Mr. Dick before the meetings.

Mr. Bowman spoke about the house remodel at 746 Walnut street and that it had been several years with no siding put on it yet. He also spoke about the back lot of Mr. Perigo's car lot, that it had been filled with gravel for additional cars. The situation was not legal Mr. Bowman said. Mr. Harris and Mr. Swick replied that Area Plan had been notified about the situation and Mr. Perigo spoken to. Mr. Bowman also spoke about needing a new sidewalk along Republican Street to Harrison Street for the school children to walk on. Mr. Merkel said that the sidewalk project was on his "To-Do" list. The final item that Mr. Bowman brought up was reminding the board that we had a registered "Historic District" for parts of Walnut and Main streets and maybe we should adopt some ordinances like the ones Lafayette had done to protect and have control over the historic area.

Mr. Carson invited the town and town board to the open house at the fire department on Saturday 9, 2011 at 4:00 pm.

Ms. Quednow mentioned that the sewer rates for commercial properties needed to be looked at to be sure they were billed at the right amount.

Mr. Merkel explained that the board had encumbered monies last year for the sidewalk work being done by Mr. Scott and for the paving work being done by American Paving.

Mr. Merkel explained the new proposal costs for Conjunction & Jefferson streets, for Conjunction and Meadow streets, and for Hines drive. This work will be done for \$24,627. Mr. Merkel made a motion to have American Paving & Asphalt Inc. do the work. Mr. Swick seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Merkel said that the town still had \$50,000. to \$55,000. to spend on roads and other sidewalks projects this year. Mr. Merkel spoke about the new street sign replacement project and the fact that the new street signs would also have the towns new logo on each one of them. He said that he would need to attend a recertification class for this project.

Mr. Swick made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Merkel seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned.
