Mr. and Mrs. Beavers briefly spoke at the meeting about their large water bill and explained the letter that they had sent to the town hall. Mr. Swick said that Mr. Whitlock would go out and read their water meter tonight and each couple weeks to see if water was leaking and causing a high bill.
