Mr. Harris made a motion to approve the minutes as written.

Mr. Merkel made a motion to move/approve the Registry of Claims at the Town Board meeting. Mr. Harris seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Harris made a motion to approve the adjustment report of 747 Walnut Street. Ms. Nice seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Whitlock gave his utility report. He reported that he had "BIF" calibrated and that he had a pump going out that Precision Power would replace soon. Mr. Whitlock said that he had talked with personnel from Dayton's fire department about using Dayton's water to fill to fill pools with. He said that the fire department fills up with Lafayette's water and no longer uses Dayton's water. Mr. Whitlock also said that he ordered the new utility meter reader and that it would come with new software and a yearly contract of \$1600.
