

THE TOWN OF DAYTON INDIANA

The Dayton Town Council met December 3, 2012 in the Dayton Town Hall at 7:00 pm. Council Members present were Ron Merkel, Mike Harris, John Swick, and Dave Leininger. Joe Bumbelburg, Town Attorney, was also present.

Mr. Swick called the meeting to order.

Mr. Merkel made a motion to approve November 5, 2012 minutes as written. Mr. Leininger seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Merkel made a motion to approve the registry of claims, dated November 5, 2012, for \$144,582.08. Mr. Swick seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Remely spoke about Dayton being ADA compliant. He described The ADA Transition Plan and the monies that would be put aside each year from Dayton to be ADA compliant. He spoke also about choosing the clerk treasurer being the ADA Coordinator. The town Board talked about the dollar amount of \$7500, being set aside each year to comply.

Mr. Leininger made a motion to adopt Ordinance no. 2012-13, "An Ordinance Adopting the Americans with Disabilities Act Transition Plan for the Town of Dayton". Mr. Merkel seconded the motion and the motion was approved.

Mr. Bumbleburg spoke about the situation with Brand's parking lot. He had talked to John Burns of Area Plan and he said that Brand needed to blacktop his parking lot. The Town Board said that they had given Brand plenty of time to conform to the agreement with the town to finish the parking lot. Mr. Bumbleburg said that he and Area Plan would write Brand a letter telling him to comply and pave the parking lot.

Mr. Goodrich gave his police report which is downloaded and attached to the minutes. He and the board talked about who gets the monies for tickets written in town.

Mr. Bowman spoke and said thanks for painting the cross walks. A manhole also needs to be cleaned out.

Mr. Leininger gave more info on the new computer system for the police. Everything was proceeding along fine.

Ms. Merkel asked about starting the December 27th meeting at 6:00pm instead of 7:00 pm so that our town Christmas party could start earlier. Also she asked about the food and what was needed at the party. The town board ok'd getting pizza, soft drinks, nuts, cookies, cake and what else was needed.

Mr. Swick mentioned that maintenance needed to be done on the town hall doors and windows. Also maintenance needed to be done at the police station with the bathroom, carpet, and the chief's office. Mr. Swick explained about some problems with the electrical wiring at the new maintenance building.

Mr. Swick made a motion to spend up to \$500.00 for a new power washer for the maintenance building. Mr. Leininger seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Merkel made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Merkel seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned.
