THE TOWN OF DAYTON INDIANA

The Dayton Town Council met July 8, 2013 in the Dayton Town Hall at 7:00 pm. Council Members present were Ron Merkel, Mike Harris, John Swick, Dave Leininger, and Tammi Nice. Joe Bumbleburg, Town Attorney, was also present.

Mr. Harris called the meeting to order.

Mr. Merkel made a motion to approve the June 3 and the June 11, 2013 minutes as written. Mr. Swick seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Leininger explained the claims report to the town's people. Mr. Merkel made a motion to approve the July 8, 2013 Registry of Claims of \$97,627.90. Mr. Leininger seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Bumbleburg explained Ordinance 2013-8, "An Ordinance for UZO Amendment #77, Extending the End Date on Elevating Structures in the Flood Plain." Mr. Swick made a motion to approve Ordinance 2013-8. Mr. Leininger seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Goodrich gave his police report which is downloaded and attached to the minutes. Mr. Leininger asked about why no Dayton police working on July 4th. Mr. Goodrich replied that the deputies could not work. Discussed was how to have police coverage in Dayton on certain critical times and when needed.

Ms. Merkel asked about Winteck bills and if we should be paying for them or not, if the system was not up and running. Mr. Leininger said that he would check into the matter.

Mr. Goodrich asked for approval to purchase a state required heat sealer kit for evidence retrieval cases. Mr. Merkel made a motion to purchase the kit for the police department. Mr. Leininger seconded the motion and the motion carried.

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Mr. Bowman told the board of several houses in town that needed to be cleaned up and the lawns mowed. He also said of the town pump house that needed the bushes trimmed back from the roofline and building. He also asked about the zoning on the old Gentry property.

Ms. Carson asked who is mowing and maintaining the field and property next to her business and next to the new CNG Fuel station. Ms. Merkel said that she could go to their website and issue a complaint for mowing and trash pick up. Ms. Carson said that Hine drive is in bad shape and falling apart. Mr. Merkel replied that Dayton will wait until the construction project is done and then repair the road as needed.

Mr. Leininger asked questions about who liked what on the new art work for the street signs that he and his son came up with. He said that he would e-mail everybody with the pictures and we would go from there. Mr. Merkel said that he was working on the funding for the street signs. Mr. Leininger also asked about the signage for the two other buildings that needed them. The board talked about several options for the signs.

Mr. Leininger said that the new town website is in the works and he will finish up soon.

Mr. Swick that he found that Shady lane was platted and not a private drive.

Mr. Koehler asked the board to rezone part of his property back to AG. The town board said that he needed to go to area plan and start the rezone process.

The town board discussed in length about the 2014 town budget.

Mr. Swick made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Leininger seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned.
