

## THE TOWN OF DAYTON INDIANA

**The Dayton Service Utility Board met Monday, September 9, 2013 in the Dayton Town Hall at 7:00pm. Members present were Ron Merkel, Mike Harris, John Swick, Dave Leininger, and Tammi Nice. Jason Ramsland, Town Attorney, was also present.**

Mr. Swick called the meeting to order.

Mr. Leininger made a motion to approve the August 5, 2013 minutes as written. Mr. Harris seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Leininger made a motion to move/approve the September 9, 2013 Registry of Claims of \$98,229.14 at the Town Board meeting. Mr. Harris seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Ms. Merkel reported on the adjustment report dated September 5, 2013 for Mr. Kaminsky, Ms. Whitted, Mr. Schneider, and Mr. Pickering. Mr. Merkel made a motion to approve the adjustment report. Mr. Harris seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Ms. Copas of 294 Harrison asked for waste water credit for a leaking toilet that kept running. Mr. Merkel said that we only give credit for waste water that does not go down sewer. Ms. Nice suggested to breakup bill into two or three payments. Mr. Harris made a motion to adjust her bill. The motion died for lack of a second.

Mr. Leininger suggested that she check with Pam Crum, the count trustee for help in paying her bill. Mr. Merkel made a motion for her to pay just her normal bill until she talks to her landlord, Mr. Stevenson to see if he can help pay the bill. Mr. Harris seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Van Horn asked for a waste water credit for filling his pool. Mr. Merkel made a motion to give Mr. VanHorn a credit for filling his pool. Mr. Leininger seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Hughes of Clifty Falls Lane asked for a credit for penalties added to his bill when the credit card machine was malfunctioning. Mr. Leininger made a motion to credit Mr. Hughes credit for penalties incurred on his bill. Mr. Merkel seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Whitlock gave his utilities report. He will have D. A. Dodd's do the backflow prevention checks from now on. Mr. Whitlock said that he received the last bill from Roger Jenkins of Precision Power. Max will check that we got everything back from Mr. Jenkins. The council discussed the bill from Mr. Jenkins for the new Pianha grinder pump and hardware and said to put it on next month claims so Mr. Whitlock would have

time to check out the cost for it. Mr. Whitlock said that he would look into the cost and see if it was right.

Mr. Harris made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Merkel seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned.
