

THE TOWN OF DAYTON INDIANA

The Dayton Service Utility Board met Monday, November 4, 2013 in the Dayton Town Hall at 7:00pm. Members present were Ron Merkel, Mike Harris, Dave Leininger, and Tammi Nice. Mr. Swick was absent. Joe Bumbleburg, Town Attorney, was also present.

Mr. Leininger called the meeting to order.

Mr. Harris made a motion to approve the October 7, 2013 minutes as written. Mr. Merkel seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Harris made a motion to move/approve the November 4, 2013 Registry of Claims of \$77,718.21 at the Town Board meeting. Mr. Harris seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Ms. Merkel reported on the adjustment report dated October 31, 2013 for Mr. Yoemen, Mr. Hamel, Mr. Edwards, and Shook Reality. Mr. Merkel made a motion to approve the adjustment report. Mr. Harris seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Nichols of 755 Clifty Falls asked for a waste water credit for watering of grass and flowers. Mr. Merkel made a motion to credit Mr. Nichols for waste water used above the average monthly amount. Mr. Harris seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Hanjie explained that some persons were dumping grass and leaves along the storm water grates at Clifty Falls. Mr. Merkel said that the streets will be swept after all the leaves are down. Mr. Hanjie asked if door hangers could be put on the doors by the police as they pass by. Mr. Harris said to go ahead and see if that corrects the problems. Mr. Merkel said he would have the pile of leaves picked up Mr. Bumbleburg suggested that the town have an ordinance giving police permission to give citations for this.

Mr. Whitlock gave his utilities report. FJK did the service on the lift stations. They still have to put in the new pump. He said that a company was doing a lot of test borings in the field by McAllister and that the town has a water line going across the field. He said that he would check with Mike Smith to see if he had maps showing where the water easements are. Mr. Whitlock said that he attended the storm water meeting.

Mr. Merkel made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Harris seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned.
