

THE TOWN OF DAYTON INDIANA

The Dayton Town Council met Monday June 2, 2014 in the Dayton Town Hall at 7:00 pm. Council Members present were Ron Merkel, John Swick, and Dave Leininger. Mike Harris and Tammi Nice were absent. Jason Ramsland, Town Attorney, was present.

Mr. Merkel called the meeting to order.

Mr. Swick made a motion to approve the Town Board meeting of May 5, 2014 and the Executive closed work sessions of May 5, 2014 and the Executive closed work session of May 10, 2014. Mr. Leininger seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Leininger read and explained the claims docket. Mr. Swick made a motion to approve the June 2, 2014 claim docket of \$87,756.78. Mr. Leininger seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Leininger made a motion to approve the Allowance docket of 5-1-2014 to 5-31-2-14. Mr. Mr. Swick seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Ramsland explained Ordinance 2014-8, "An Ordinance adopting the APC Ordinance Committee's Recommended Fee Schedule under Section 6-2-6(b) of The Unified Zoning Ordinance".

Mr. Swick made a motion to suspend the rules and read in title only Ordinance 2014-8. Mr. Leininger seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Swick made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2014-8 on second reading. Mr. Leininger seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Ramsland explained Ordinance 2014-9, "An Ordinance to Alter the Handling of the Dayton Town Marshal Department's Uniform Allowance". The town council discussed in detail the clothing ordinance.

Mr. Leininger made a motion to approve Ordinance 2014-9, An Ordinance to Alter the Handling of the Dayton Town Marshal Department's Uniform Allowance". Mr. Swick seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Swick made a motion to suspend the rules and read in title only Ordinance 2014-9. Mr. Leininger seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Swick made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2014-9 on second reading. Mr. Leininger seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Hanjie gave the police activity report which is downloaded and attached to the minutes.

He explained that there will be three deputies at the annual fireworks display this year instead of two. The celebration is to be held at 6:30 pm on Sunday 29th.

Mr. Swick asked how many marshal applicants were turned in so far. Mr. Merkel said that about eight or nine were turned so far. A new meeting date was set up for June 16th to discuss the applicants. He said that he would like the HR guy to be at the meeting to help guide the board.

Mr. Swick asked about the new small sign put up in front of Decks Unlimited. Mr. Merkel said that he thought the real estate sized signs were ok but not the larger ones. Mr. Swick said that he just wanted everyone on the same playing field. The town council discussed in detail about the signs put in Dayton. Also talked about was putting up a larger

sign/mural in the center of town with all with all the businesses on them. The council said that small signs that helped the businesses were helpful to bring business into the town.

Mr. Merkel talked about different streets that were to be repaired and paved. Conjunction Street and Hine Drive was to be fixed also. Discussed was what to do about the semi damage around the CNG station.

All the town streets are in decent shape but are cracking somewhat and need to be sealed. Mr. Merkel said that he had got an estimate of \$80,000 to reseal all the streets in town. He suggested that the council think about sealing one third of the town's streets each year.

Mr. Merkel explained that more driveways needed to be fixed up in the Cagels Mill subdivision.

Mr. Swick made a motion to have Scott Contracting do 20 more driveway entrances in Cagels Mill subdivision. Mr. Merkel seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Hanjie talked about several street areas by the fire department and school that needed to be dealt with.

Mr. Merkel said the road sign project was bid in at \$31,000, a lot lower than estimated. He was meeting with them next week.

Mr. Swick made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Leininger seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned.
