The Dayton Town Council met Monday April 6, 2015 in the Dayton Town Hall at 7:00 pm. Council Members present were Ron Merkel, Mike Harris, John Swick, Dave Leininger and Tammi Nice. Joe Bumbleburg, Town Attorney, was present.

Mr. Swick called the meeting to order.

Mr. Leininger made a motion to approve the Town Board minutes of March 2, 2015 and the Town Board Special meeting minutes of March 19, 2015.

Mr. Harris seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Leininger made a motion to approve the April 6, 2015 claims docket of \$98,426.67 and the March 31, 2015 allowance docket of \$21,536.56. Ms. Nice seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Swick asked for comments from the residents. There were none.

Mr. Koehler gave his clerk treasurer report. He asked the council if they wanted any changes in the values on the towns building or the contents of them. Mr. Swick said to talk about this at the next meeting.

Mr. Swick said that the mid-monthly meeting should be called a "caucus".

Mr. Koehler showed pictures of the overflowing large dumpster that was put up at the police station for the residents. The council talked about how the dumpster was abused by people filling it up to the top where trash and mattresses were falling out on the ground.

The council discussed this in detail how to avoid this situation. It was decided that maybe the full dumpster should be removed at the end of the day so it could not be abused. Also another dumpster should be put in place of the full one instead of a time lapse between so people could not throw trash on the ground.

Mr. Bumbleburg explained the parking on town sidewalks is prohibited even when the sidewalk crosses the driveway. He explained the ordinance prohibiting trash, dirt, and miscellaneous on the sidewalks. He suggested combining the ordinance for the sidewalks.

Mr. Bumbleburg explained the filing of Commitments for MacAllister.

Mr. Bumbleburg explained Ordinance 2015-2, "An ordinance Establishing Salary and Compensation for employees and Elected officers and Correcting a Scrivener's Error in Ordinance 2013-11". Mr. Harris made a motion to approve Ordinance 2015-2. Mr. Merkel seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Harris made a motion to suspend the rules and read in title only Ordinance 2015-2, "An Ordinance Establishing Salary and Compensation for Employees and Elected Officers and Correcting a Scrivener's Error in Ordinance 2013-11".

Mr. Merkel seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Swick read Ordinance 2015-2 in title only. No motion was made or seconded. A vote of 5 in favor was recorded.

Marshal Taylor gave his police activity report which is downloaded and attached to the report. The council discussed the activity report.

Marshal Taylor explained the computer update, scammers at the gas station, Frontier's reduced bill, noise complaints of the CNG and Circle K station compressors, citations given for cars to be removed and the enforcement of "shut down at dusk" rules at the Dayton cemetery.

Marshal explained the kinds of police body cameras available. The council discussed the cameras for \$325. Mr. Merkel made a motion to buy a body camera for \$325 to try. Ms. Nice seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Marshal asked to purchase car jacks and a wrench for each of the police cars to help citizens change a tire. Mr. Swick asked if the town was covered by insurance. Mr. Harris made a motion to purchase two car jacks. Ms. Nice seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Marshal asked to purchase \$400 to \$500 of practice ammo instead of using the regular more expensive ammo.

Mr. Merkel made a motion to purchase \$400 to \$500 of practice ammo for the year. Ms. Nice seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Leininger explained the Dayton garage sales that are held when the fish fry weekend is. He said that he has everyone's e-mail account is set up now and explained it. Mr. Leininger discussed the Dayton watchdog site. Mr. Merkel asked Mr. Leininger to put on the website to let the town clerk know of pot holes that needed to be filled.

Ms. Bianca discussed the MacAllister project again and asked the council to approve the improvement location permit as it stands now. Mr. Bumbleburg said that the council did not have the authority to approve the improvement location permit with the current zoning. Mr. Bumbleburg said MacAllister should start the re-zone immediately so they can get their permits.

Mr. Leininger made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Discussion on how to close the meeting followed.
