The Dayton Town Council met Monday May 4, 2015 in the Dayton Town Hall at 7:00 pm. Council Members present were Mike Harris, John Swick, and Tammi Nice. Joe Bumbleburg, Town Attorney, was present.

Mr. Swick called the meeting to order.

Mr. Harris made a motion to approve the Town Board minutes of April 4, 2015 and the Town Board Caucus meeting minutes of April 25, 2015.

Ms. Nice seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Harris made a motion to approve the May 4, 2015 claims docket of \$109,733.83 and the April 1, 2015 allowance docket of \$21,201.69. Ms. Nice seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Swick asked for comments from the residents.

Mr. Sleigel of 1336 East 510 south, Lafayette asked if he could get permission to park on the Dayton lot by the Police station, so he could carpool. There would be 2-3 cars involved. Discussion on liability insurance, zoning and not exclusive to just them. It was decided to look into the matter and take it under consideration.

Ms. Alice Delph of 209 Clifty Falls explained about the concerns with Marshal Taylor. The council discussed in detail her concerns.

Mr. Leininger of 764 Shady Lane said that it was a pleasure working on the town council but was with a new world wide company and could not be on the council. He said that he would still like to help with the town's website. He could help the transition and maybe with the help of Cindy Marsh keep the site going and heal some issues.

Mr. Merkel of 756 Shady Lane also thanked the council for his time on the town board. He explained now he and Mr. Taylor were planning a town clean-up, then go on to


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organizing other monthly events that would help the community. He asked for help with police coverage, a few safety vests, trash bags, trash sticks and money to buy food for a cookout after the cleanup. The event was Saturday at 9:00 am. Ms. Nice made a motion to buy vests for up to \$100 and \$250 for food and drinks. Mr. Harris seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Tyrone Taylor said he was interested in one of the empty council seats. Mr. Swick said that these seats would be for filling the at-large empty seats.

Mr. Ramsland explained how to fill the seats. The council said to post a notice at town hall and the post office for applicants to be interviewed at the next meeting. They would need to fill out an application at the town hall.

Mr. Koehler had no clerk treasurer report. Mr. Bumbleburg explained the creation of forms for requests of public records from the town hall.

Mr. Ramsland read Side walk Ordinance 2015-3.

Mr. Harris made a motion to adopt Side walk Ordinance 2015-3. Ms. Nice seconded the motion and the motion was approved.

Mr. Harris suspended the rules and read in title only Ordinance 2015-3. Ms. Nice seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Harris made a motion to approve Side walk Ordinance 2015-3. Ms. Nice seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Ramsland read and explained Ordinance 2015-4, PD Checkpoints and List and Animal Specialties.

Mr. Harris made a motion to approve Ordinance 2015-4. Ms. Nice seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Marshal Taylor gave his police activity report which is downloaded and attached to the report. The council discussed the activity report.

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Ms. Watts of BF&S explained the Phase 2 review on MacAllister Machinery. Everything is compliant and in order. There are no changes to the service utility agreement because they are doing no wash basin yet. If they do the wash basin then a new utilities agreement would need to be done.

Mr. Harris made a motion to approve plans from BF&S. Ms. Nice seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Ms. Bianca of Structurepoint said that MacAllister will comply with BF&S review plans.

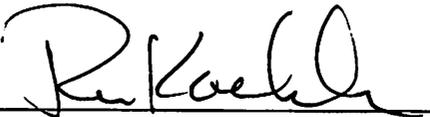
