

THE TOWN OF DAYTON INDIANA

The Dayton Service Utility Board met Monday August 3, 2015 in the Dayton Town Hall at 7:00pm. Members present were Ashley Stevenson, Mike Harris, John Swick, Tyrone Taylor and Tammi Nice. Jason Ramsland, Town Attorney, was also present.

Ms. Nice called the Service Utility Board to order.

Mr. Swick made a motion to approve the Utility minutes of July 6, 2015 as written. Mr. Harris seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Ms. Nice asked about the legal bill for Withered Burns attorneys. Mr. Ramsland said he and that the town should pay for two entries of the bill which totaled \$415.50. Mr. Swick made a motion to approve the claims with only \$415.50 paid to Withered Burns. Mr. Koehler asked to speak. Mr. Swick said that a motion was on the floor. Mr. Harris seconded the motion and the motion carried. Mr. Koehler said that the state, the state access councilor, and my attorneys all said that I have the right to have legal representation paid for by the town. The council and Mr. Koehler discussed the matter.

Ms. Merkel explained the Adjustment report Of 7-31-2015 for Ms. Brooke, Ms. Spencer, and Mr. McClean. Mr. Harris made a motion to approve the Adjustment docket of 7-30-2015. Mr. Taylor seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Mr. Hedger of 725 Walnut Street, asked for a waste water credit for leaking water not going down the drain. Mr. Swick made a motion to adjust Mr. Hedger's bill. Mr. Taylor seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Ms. Nice asked for comments from the residents. There were none.

Mr. Koehler asked if the residents were allowed to speak later in a council meeting if there was discussion going on about a particular topic' even though they had already spoke at the "residents time to speak on the agenda"? Ms. Nice said that was fine with her. Mr. Swick asked if we were just talking about the Utility meeting or both. Mr. Koehler the utility meeting for now. The council discussed the matter in detail and decided to let the residents talk at different times.

Mr. Koehler explained that his company did the town hall spring cleanup, bark mulching, flowering and also the town entrance beds. The cost was around \$800 or so and was donated to the town at no cost.

Mr. Swick explained the need to clean up the dich on Mr. Bull's property. The council discussed the problem with the ditches and how to get them cleaned.

Mr. Whitlock gave his utility report. All the back flow valves would be checked and the main water would be turned off for a couple hours. IDEM inspection had been completed two weeks ago and the town passed with flying colors. He had worked the 4-h fair. Everything else was fine.

The council set a meeting for Saturday August 15th, at 8am, to discuss a replacement for Mr. Whitlock.

Mr. Swick made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Harris seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned.
