## WATER, SANITARY SEWER & STORM UTILITY PLANNING PROJECT PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

On or about November 15, 2024, the Town of Dayton intends to apply to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs for a grant from the State Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program Planning Grant Program. This program is funded by Title I of the federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. These funds are to be used for a community development project that will include the following activities: the completion of a water, sanitary sewer and storm utility master planning study (preliminary engineering report). The total amount of CDBG funds to be requested is \$86,000. The amount of CDBG funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit low-and moderate-income persons is estimated to be over \$50,164. The Applicant also proposes to expend an estimated \$10,000 in non-CDBG funds on the project. These non-CDBG funds will be derived from the following sources: \$10,000.00 from ARP (2401) Fund.

The Town of Dayton will hold a public hearing on October 15, 2024, at 7:00 p.m., at the Dayton Town Hall located at 721 Walnut Street, Dayton, Indiana to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed federally funded CDBG project.
