Rocky called the meeting to order. Present at the meeting were Rocky Richards, Utility Board President, Marc Buhrmester, Steve Schule and Mike Harris. Carla Snodgrass was absent. Also present was Attorney Eric Burns.

Rocky made motion to accept the Adjustment Reports for February & March 2026.
Marc Buhrmester seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote: Steve-Yes, Mike-Yes, Rocky-Yes, Marc-Yes.

Town Manager

- **2026 Hydrant Maintenance and Flushing Proposal update** - Kurt Deltzer reported that this has not been scheduled. They should have a date soon.
- We are still waiting on the quotes for generator hook-up.
- FJF said they will be here next week if all goes well and they don't get any service calls.
- Dumpster Day is schedule for May 30, 2026, 8am – 5pm.
- Kurt provided quotes he received from the paving company to crack seal Dayton Road. The first quote of \$5,200 was to crack seal Dayton Road from the edge of the concrete pavement on US 38 to where the County's section of Dayton Road begins. Kurt said that he is still waiting on a quote to crack seal just the County's section of Dayton Road. The quote to mill and pave that same section would be \$70,000. After the council's discussion, it was determined that they cannot make any decisions at this time until the paving company provides all quotes.

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- Kurt then informed the council that he is still going after that valve over by Macallister's and the water valve. Our option now is to get a vac truck and vac down to the main to see if it is there or not. Kurt asked for the council's approval to hire a back truck. It is a 4-hour minimum job at \$260.00 per hour. There is no dump fee, but there is a \$150.00 trip charge. Kurt was confident that the total charge would not go over \$2,000. Steve Schule made a motion to approve Kurt to hire a back truck for a fee not to exceed \$1,600. Rock Richards seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote: Mike-Yes, Steve-Yes, Rocky-Yes, Marc-Yes. Motion carried 4-0
- Marshall Taylor asked to address the council as an add on to the Town Manager's Report. Marshall Taylor stated that over the past month Kurt has been working in the Police Department. He has installed new flooring and painted the walls in the Lobby. He has completed the work, and it looks great and was very much appreciated. Kurt has saved the department approximately \$3,000 and deserved the Council's recognition. Council expressed their appreciation.


