Attorney: Patrick Jones present. No updates

Adjustment Report: Rocky Richards made a motion to accept April Adjustment Report. Marc 2nd motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Town Manager:

2026 Hydrant Maint. And Flushing. Completed week of May 11th.

Wabash Valley Hydro-vac for valves update. To be scheduled.

Lift Station Maint. by FJF. Cleaned week of May 11th. 2 options provided moving forward.

Option 1: color code wiring for ease of operation and a generator to test. Cost of project \$13,870.

Option 2: Continue with the current process.

Marc made motion to set up lift stations. Steve S. 2nd. Motion carried unanimously.

Dayton Road crack/seal paving proposal.

Patrick Jones advised amending proposal to remove verbiage 3rd to last and last bullet point. Mark made motion to approve project with verbiage removed. Steve S. 2nd. Motion carried unanimously.

280 Dayton Road tree removal proposal.

Residents provided info on current situation. Town mgr. provided info on cost of removal, but will follow up with a formal quote. Mike Harris made motion to approve removal of two trees. Rocky 2nd. Mike H., Rocky R. and Marc B. approved. Carla S. and Steve S. abstained the vote.

Drainage ditch cleanout proposal.

Discussion on Right of way or easement. Council to identify responsibility to keep it cleared out to prevent stormwater backing up in town. Mike H. made a motion to table the issue until the June meeting to get more details on responsible parties. Steve S. 2nd motion. Motion carried unanimously.
