Notice is hereby given to taxpayers of **DAYTON CIVIL TOWN, Tippecanoe County, Indiana** that the proper officers of **Dayton Civil Town** will conduct a public hearing on the year **2025** budget. Following this meeting, any ten or more taxpayers may object to a budget, tax rate, or tax levy by filing an objection petition with the proper officers of **Dayton Civil Town** not more than seven days after the hearing. The objection petition must identify the provisions of the budget, tax rate, or tax levy to which taxpayers object. If a petition is filed, **Dayton Civil Town** shall adopt with the budget a finding concerning the objections in the petition and testimony presented.
