


ORDINANCE 2020- 7

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE TOWN OF DAYTON CHAPTER 91: ANIMALS

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Dayton has the duty and authority to increase public safety and enhance the public welfare by regulating the possession and treatment of animals in the Town of Dayton;

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Dayton had previously adopted Chapter 91 of the Code of Ordinances for the Town of Dayton concerning Animal Control that adopted by reference the Animal Control Ordinance for Unincorporated Tippecanoe County (93-25-CM);

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Tippecanoe County adopted Ordinance 2019-30-CM, which amended the Animal Control Ordinance for Unincorporated Tippecanoe County and is attached as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Dayton seeks to update Chapter 91 of the Code of Ordinances for the Town of Dayton:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Dayton, Indiana, that the Code of Ordinances for the Town of Dayton be amended by repealing existing Chapter 91 and replacing it with a new Chapter 91 as follows:

91.01 ADOPTING COUNT ANIMAL CONTROL REGULATIONS BY REFERENCE

(A) The Animal Control Ordinance for Unincorporated Tippecanoe County (2019-30-CM) as amended, is incorporated by reference as part of this chapter and it is hereby enacted and adopted and approved as a general ordinance of the Town of Dayton.

(B) Two copies of the Animal Control Ordinance for Unincorporated Tippecanoe County (2019-30-CM) as amended, are on file in the office of the Town Clerk-Treasurer for public inspection.

(C) The Sheriff of Tippecanoe County or an individual designated as the Animal Control Officer by the Sheriff of Tippecanoe County is hereby recognized as an appropriate enforcement authority for violations of the Animal Control Ordinance within the Town of Dayton.

This Ordinance supersedes all prior ordinances regarding animal control.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and signing and publication as required by law.
