ORDINANCE NO. <u>2023-1</u>

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A "DONATION – COMMUNITY ENRICHMENT FUND" PURSUANT TO INDIANA CODE 36-1-3

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 36-1-3-4 provides a municipality all powers necessary to conduct its affairs, even if not expressly granted by statute;

WHEREAS, the Town of Dayton, Indiana (hereinafter the "Town") receives donations from private individuals and entities for the purpose of community enrichment;

WHEREAS, the Town has determined it is necessary to establish a "Donation –

Community Enrichment Fund," which shall be funded by said donations made for such purposes;

WHEREAS, the funds may be expended pursuant to Ordinance 34.10 Promoting

Municipal Betterment for the purposes the Town Council of the Town of Dayton, Indiana, deems

are directly related to the promotion and betterment of the Town; and

WHEREAS, such "Donation – Community Enrichment Fund" shall continue in existence until such time as the Town Council of the Town of Dayton, Indiana, determines such fund shall be terminated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF TOWN OF DAYTON, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

- There is hereby established a "Donation Community Enrichment Fund" to receive donations made by private individuals and/or entities for the purpose of community enrichment.
- 2. That the funds may be expended for the purposes the Town Council of the Town of Dayton, Indiana, deems are directly related to the promotion and betterment of the Town;

- 3. The "Donation Community Enrichment Fund" shall continue in existence until such time as the Town Council of the Town of Dayton, Indiana, determines such fund shall be terminated.
- 4. No part of this Ordinance shall be interpreted to conflict with any local, state, or federal laws, and all reasonable efforts should be made to harmonize the same. Should any section or part of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any portion thereof other than that portion so declared to be invalid, and for this purpose, the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.
 - 5. This Ordinance shall be in effect upon its adoption.


