A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE TRANSFER OF TASER X26P DEVICE AND RELATED EQUIPMENT FROM TIPPECANOE COUNTY TO TOWN OF DAYTON, INDIANA

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 36-1-3-4 provides a municipality all powers necessary to conduct its affairs, even if not expressly granted by statute; and

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 5-22-22-10 permits the exchange of property between governmental bodies for any amount of property or cash as agreed upon by the governmental bodies; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Dayton, Indiana (hereinafter the "Town") maintains a police department to provide police protection services to the Town; and

WHEREAS, Tippecanoe County, Indiana, has determined that it has a certain Taser device and related equipment that it no longer needs; and

WHEREAS, the Town's police department has determined that it has a need for this equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Dayton, Indiana, that:

- 1. The Town hereby accepts the Taser X26P serial number X12006111 with associated cartridge and holster from Tippecanoe County, Indiana.
 - Such transfer of ownership shall be for no charge to the Town.
- 3. The Town accepts this equipment on an "as is" basis and shall hold harmless Tippecanoe County, Indiana, and the Tippecanoe County Sheriff's Department from claims related to the equipment or its use.
 - 4. This resolution shall be effective as of the date of its adoption.
