# TOWN OF DAYTON, INDIANA ORDINANCE NO. 2024-24

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE SECTION 30.02, FEES PERTAINING TO DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 36-1-3-4 provides a municipality all powers necessary to conduct its affairs, even if not expressly granted by statute;

WHEREAS, the Town of Dayton, Indiana, (hereinafter the "Town") adopted § 30.02 "Fees Pertaining to Documents" in Ordinance No. 04-05 on May 3, 2004, and amended in Ordinance 2011-11 on December 5, 2011;

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Dayton, Indiana (hereinafter the "Council") believes it is in the best interest of the Town to further amend § 30.02 to update the methods in which documents and photographs are conveyed and the price associated with the dissemination of information requested by the public.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DAYTON, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Town of Dayton, Indiana, Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by amending § 30.02 as follows:

### § 30.02 FEES PERTAINING TO DOCUMENTS

Pursuant to Indiana Code § 5-14-3-8, the town shall collect the following fees for the collection, reproduction and dissemination of information requested by the public:

(A) The following fee schedule applies to the Town of Dayton, Indiana, Clerk-Treasurer's Office for duplication and provision of services:
