



Unified Zoning Ordinance Amendment #117 SPECIAL EXCEPTION TERMINATION AMENDMENT

Staff Report MARCH 13, 2025

BACKGROUND:

When presented with a proposed process and form for termination of a previously approved Special Exception, (SE), the Ordinance Committee, together with members of the ABZA, discussed amending the ordinance so that only an Administrative Officer would be allowed to file a petition to terminate a [previously approved] special exception. To the best of APC staff's knowledge, terminating an SE has never been attempted. Since the UZO provides a pathway for the BZA to do so, it was deemed prudent to clarify that process.

The proposed amendment would make changes to Chapter 6-4-4(j) of the UZO: (edits are shown in red)

"A **special exception** may be terminated by the **ABZA** if it finds a failure to comply with the terms of this ordinance or to conditions or commitments attached to its approval. An application to terminate may be filed by an interested person, or a staff member or an **Administrative Officer**. The **ABZA** may take this action only at a public hearing, having given notice of that hearing to the property owner."

The proposed amendment would remove the possibility of a member of the public filing an application to terminate, and place the responsibility entirely in the hands of an Administrative Officer (AO). The County has three such AO's: Lafayette, West Lafayette, and County. All have been involved in discussions with APC staff regarding the proposal, and all are in support.

The Ordinance Committee approved this amendment at its February 5, 2025 meeting.
